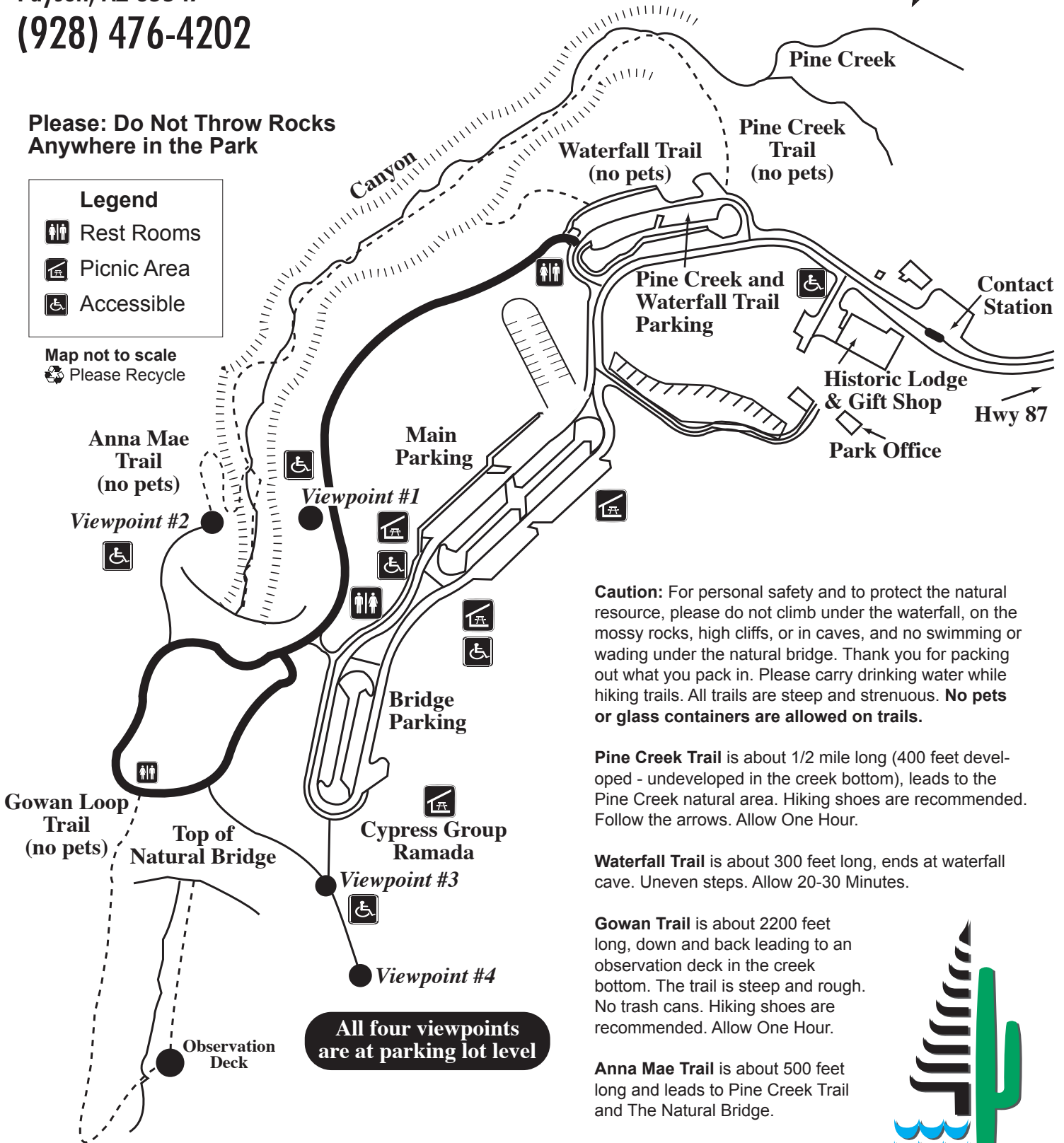

Caution: For personal safety and to protect the natural resource, please do not climb under the waterfall, on the mossy rocks, high cliffs, or in caves, and no swimming or wading under the natural bridge. Thank you for packing out what you pack in. Please carry drinking water while hiking trails. All trails are steep and strenuous. **No pets or glass containers are allowed on trails.**

Pine Creek Trail is about 1/2 mile long (400 feet developed - undeveloped in the creek bottom), leads to the Pine Creek natural area. Hiking shoes are recommended. Follow the arrows. Allow One Hour.

Waterfall Trail is about 300 feet long, ends at waterfall cave. Uneven steps. Allow 20-30 Minutes.

Gowan Trail is about 2200 feet long, down and back leading to an observation deck in the creek bottom. The trail is steep and rough. No trash cans. Hiking shoes are recommended. Allow One Hour.

Anna Mae Trail is about 500 feet long and leads to Pine Creek Trail and The Natural Bridge.
