

**OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE ADVISORY GROUP (OHVAG)

The Arizona State Parks Board appoints the seven-member, volunteer Off-Highway Vehicle Advisory Group (OHVAG). The OHVAG advises the Arizona State Parks Board on the development and implementation of the Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Recreation Plan, as well as expenditures from the Arizona Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Fund (ARS §28-1176) and Federal Recreational Trails Program (Motorized Portion). Each individual is appointed to a three-year term. The Group meets several times annually at locations around the State, normally on a weekday. Travel expenses are reimbursed per state guidelines. Nominees must be Arizona residents in order to be eligible, and no more than two OHVAG members may reside in the same county. Five of the seven members must be affiliated with an OHV organization or group; the remaining two seats must represent casual OHV recreationists or the general public.

The Off-Highway Vehicle Advisory Group will nominate new members in November, 2007. At the end of 2007, there will be **three** vacancies on the OHVAG, two for individuals from an OHV organization and one for a citizen-at-large. New member terms begin January, 2008 and continue until December, 2010.
